In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs and agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any horse sports activities.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the activities and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur.

I agree to wear an approved helmet at all times whilst participating in the sport where this is required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations.

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement and fully understand its terms and sign it freely and voluntarily.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The event is open to all purebred and part-bred Standardbreds (proof of registration with any recognised Standardbred Association is required for part-breds or pure-breds that do not carry a freezebrand).
2. Event will be run under Equestrian Australia (EFA) rules.
3. EFA standard footwear & head protection must be worn; helmets must comply with EFA rules. AFTER has a no helmet – no ride policy. **No exceptions.**
4. A completed insurance waiver must be submitted with nomination form.
5. No fresh nominations or nomination amendments will be accepted on the day.
6. Any stallions attending the event must wear recognised EFA stallion tags at all times during the event (as per EFA protocols). Kits can be purchased from www.equestrian.org.au
7. Stallions must only be handled and ridden by persons 18 years or over at all times during the event.
8. One rider may enter more than one horse.
9. A horse may only be ridden by one rider.
10. Horse & Rider combination must enter the entire series in order to be eligible for State Champion awards.
11. Horse and rider combination must ride both tests in a level in order to place in that level.
12. The beginners section is only open to a horse and rider combination that has competed in three or less dressage competitions (official or unofficial).
13. Horse and rider combination may only contest one level for champion in the dressage section and one level in the caprilli section.
14. Horse and rider combination may enter a maximum of three dressage tests and three caprilli tests on each day of competition. Tests must be in consecutive levels of competition (e.g. beginner/ preparatory, preparatory/ preliminary, preliminary/ novice).
15. Rider must present to a steward for a gear check 15 minutes prior to their first dressage test on each day of competition.
16. If you withdraw from any stage of the event, you will not receive a refund of your nomination fees unless a vet or medical certificate is provided to the AFTER committee.
17. Bad language, inappropriate behaviour or abuse of officials, volunteers, other competitors or spectators will not be tolerated.
18. Abuse of horses will not be tolerated.
19. No dogs allowed on grounds.
20. All horses must present for competition drug free.
21. The organisers reserve the right to vary the time & sequence of events in the program & to refuse or cancel any entry without giving any reason to do so & no claims shall be made against the organisers by reason of any such refusal or cancellation.
22. Competitors who disobey these rules may be disqualified from the entire event without refund of entry fees.
23. Nominations will not be accepted without the appropriate fees and completed waiver.

PROTESTS

24. Protests must be submitted within 30 minutes of the incident occurring and a \$50– fee will apply. The fee will only be refunded if the protest is upheld.
