OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

RULES & CONDITIONS

1. Registration to this event is considered your acknowledgment and acceptance of the rules and conditions.
2. An Equestrian Australia (EA) Member Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement must be completed by all participants, including fence-sitters.
3. EA standard footwear & head protection must be worn; helmets must comply with EA rules. No helmet, no ride – no exceptions.
4. No dogs allowed on grounds.
5. Stallions/ colts must be handled by a capable person 18 years or over at all times and must be clearly identified as an 'entire' (please contact Secretary for full instructions if you intend bringing a stallion/ colt to the event).
6. The organisers reserve the right to vary the time & sequence of events in the program & to refuse or cancel any entry without giving any reason to do so & no claims shall be made against the organisers by reason of any such refusal or cancellation.
7. Yards and stables must not be used by any person unless the appropriate fee has been paid.
8. Bad language, inappropriate behaviour or abuse of officials, volunteers, other competitors or spectators will not be tolerated.
9. Abuse of horses will not be tolerated.
10. No horses are to be locked in the round yard over night.
11. No horses are to be locked in the dressage arena over night.
12. Yards and stables are to be left clean and free of manure and other rubbish.
13. Participants who disobey these rules may be disqualified from the entire event without refund of entry fees.

Horse sports are a dangerous activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs and agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any horse sports activities.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the activities and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur.

I agree to wear an approved helmet at all times whilst participating in the sport where this is required under the relevant EA and FEI rules and regulations.
